## **About the Pathways**

There will be opportunities to learn with educators along grade bands and content-focused pathways.

#### ELA Pathway K-5, 6-8, 9-12

Participants learn and practice crafting supports and scaffolds that help address students' unfinished ELA instruction while maintaining the rigor and demands of the standards and curriculum. Participants explore the commitment, knowledge, and skills necessary to use ELA standards, texts, and tasks to provide all students access to GLEAM™ instruction. They leave with a personal action plan for bringing GLEAM™ instruction to life in their ELA classrooms.

#### Leadership Pathway K-5, 6-8, 9-12

Participants learn key concepts of ELA and math instruction in order to develop a deeper understanding of each subject area. Participants will consider key components of planning, instructional delivery, and coaching that lead to GLEAM™ instruction. They also unpack their roles as leaders in educational equity and leave Standards Institute with a personal action plan to lead GLEAM™ instruction to life in their schools
